Our fees underwrite common space for all residents which includes: indoor and outdoor dining areas, a fine restaurant, office space, indoor pool, fitness center, living room, library, lounge area, and two hotel-type guest rooms, ample storage and underground parking. We also staff with a concierge, bookkeeper, night and weekend security, a housekeeping department, a facilities department, kitchen crew, and dining

room servers. Monthly fees range from ~\$4200-\$5200, depending on unit size and number of occupants. We maintain the best staff by paying fair and competitive salaries including health benefits, vacation and holiday time, and a matching 401K plan. Work out the expense involved with a 2,000 square foot + home and be surprised at what home ownership costs you now.

Cost of 5 gourmet dinners/week		5 gourmet 4-course dinners per week at \$10.50 per resident, to cover the food cost. A \$3 fee is charged for room service. Coffee, tea, and biscotti are free and available Monday-Saturday mornings.
Entertaining Out		\$15.75 per guest instead of \$50 a plate, or more.
Maintenance/Replacement of roof, paint, carpeting, landscaping, insulated windows		Included in monthly fee is money to fully fund reserves here to cover this type of work to all common areas, with no surprise assessments.
